A national survey reveals that 68 percent of residents making less than \$21,000 per year, do not have any emergency funds saved. United Way of Florida's ALICE Report, updated for 2017, shows this problem is even more textured. In addition to those living below the federal poverty level, nearly six million more Floridians living just above the poverty line still struggle to pay for the basic costs of living

To address this issue, CDC of Tampa has created collective impact models that bundle services to increase the likelihood of becoming financially self-sufficient. Through our collective partnerships, we have helped thousands of residents increase their assets – homeownership, savings, education, small business, and income – which has been the hallmark of CDC of Tampa since its inception. Safe & Sound Hillsborough to Host Inaugural Violence Prevention Conference

On June 3, Safe & Sound Hillsborough will host its inaugural Violence Prevention Conference, SafeSummit'17. Located at the University Mall, this event will bring residents from all over Hillsborough County together with community agencies, healthcare professionals, law enforcement, support services, along with private sector and faith based leaders, with a focus on healing our communities and developing strategies and solutions to prevent violence from spreading in Hillsborough County.

There will be three main components during this event. A Reentry Roundtable will discuss employment strategies for ex-offenders. A Youth Summit entitled TEENtalk will allow Hillsborough County teens and young adults to speak on



Public Health Summit will address Substance Abuse, Mental Health, Domestic Violence and other issues that contribute to violence in our communities. Our 2017 conference will focus on cultures and effects of violence – how we learn violence, the context of violence, and culturally impacted responses to the root causes of violence.

Join us this year as we consider these issues and discuss how communities have and can continue to come together to effectively understand the impacts of violence on resiliency, why it affects people in different ways, and the exportation of the effects of violence. We will spend the day exploring what works, where there are challenges, how to communicate better with each other, and how to collectively move to solutions.

Unfortunately, we did not foresee what was going to happen. Our taxes sky rocketed and my mortgage went from \$1,500 to \$2,100 a month. This is when the domino effect happened. Since 2007 I have been back and forth with my mortgage company trying to save my home. My home was in foreclosure and was ready for sale. After many sleepless nights, the only thing I could do was pray. I decided if God wanted this home for me and my family, I would be able to somehow retain it. I left my faith in God's hands.


